This document serves to inform users about the release of the “Epson Label Editor lite Ver. 1.38 for Mac”. This application was uploaded onto Apple iTunes app store. The application was optimized with Mac OS 11.1 Big Sur.

This application runs normally with printer driver Ver. 1.39.

This is a printing application for Epson Label printers in order to edit print objects. An end user can use this application on a Mac with installed printer driver.

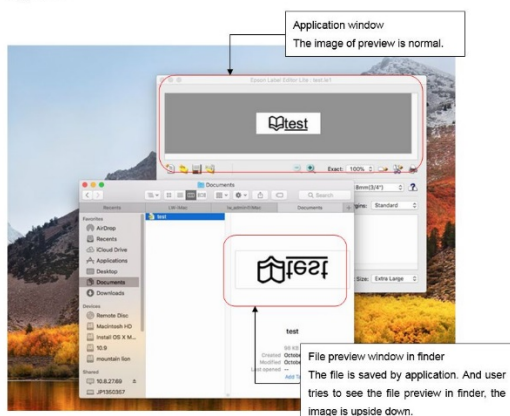

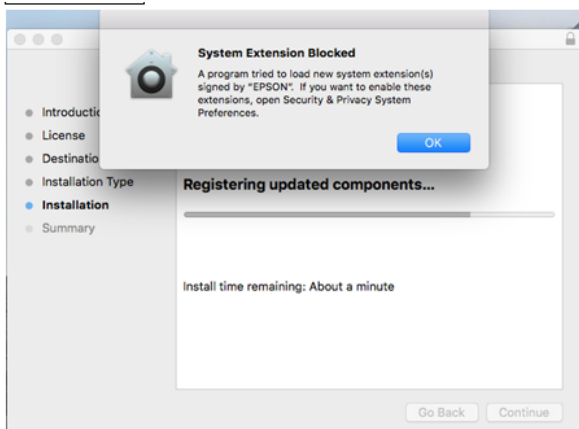

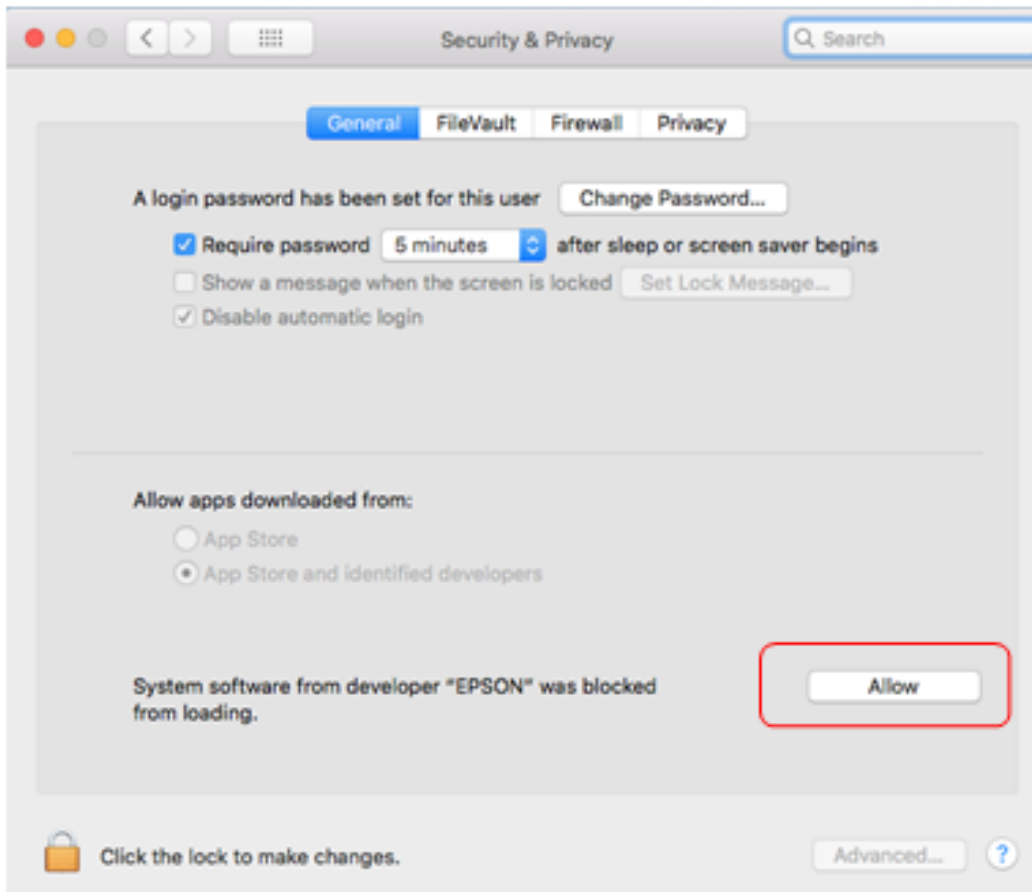
During installation of Epson Label Printer Driver with macOS 10.13 (High Sierra), first time users will see this alert.

This alert is to inform the blocked system extension for Epson label printer driver.



To Allow for Epson Label Printer Driver:

- ✓ Open System Preferences
- ✓ Open Security & Privacy on the General tab and click "Allow" near the message about system software from EPSON



- ✓ If users execute a print job without approved Kernel Extension Loading on their system, users will see the alert dialog.
